How often do you notice the art that is around you?

These are questions I have been asking over the last few years of studying creative mindfulness and positive psychology while making art which catches the light and twinkles to remind you that it is there.

A perpetual student and solution seeker, I began to study energy and environment by looking at how the colours and choices of art and furnishings impact our wellbeing and how we can use this to positively affect our emotional temperature.

As a Royal Academy shortlisted artist and qualified Creative Mindfulness Practitioner with a BA in Design and a diploma in Modern Psychology I have used my expertise and experience to design and put together my thoughts and discoveries on how to create a more positively charged environment.

Colour Matching

I started my painting career as a graduate in 1999. At the time I lived in a tiny studio flat, one day I saw some people carrying a load of wooden frames out of the basement flat and were throwing them away.

So I took them and cut up an old blanket, stretched the pieces around the frames and painted them in bright colours using emulsion tester pots left over from my design degree. I then stitched beads and sequins over them in geometric shapes and sent them to an exhibition at the old Aldwych Tube Station in London. I sold half my work in four days!



I now offer a service of colour matched abstract canvases, which can be ordered on a commission only basis so your artwork is unique and special only to you.

Twenty or so years on, this is still how I work now, except I live in a house and mostly paint on canvas. I still like to recycle and upcycle though. Household emulsion is still one of my favourite paints to use and I like to combine it with other paints and materials.









This pair of abstract canvases uses a specific mix of colours designed to enhance a space.

With many people spending much more time at home; a trend which is set to continue, I use a selection of paints which harmonise with the surroundings. I will use the colours painted on the walls and carefully select two or three other colours which will compliment them and induce feelings of calm or excitement depending on what the space is intended to be used for.

This pair of canvases are painted in Little Greene *Confetti, Tabernacle, Bath Stone, Leather* and *Canton*.

This harmonises the canvas with its surroundings and provides the viewer with increased satisfaction of their environment.



Inside the psychology of colour, there are standard ideas that colours affect how we feel in different rooms, for example sleeping in a light blue or lilac environment is relaxing, brighter yellows and reds are chosen for entertaining. But I believe we all experience colour differently and need different colours to pick us up or calm us down at different times in our lives, different times of year and for a variety of occasions.

This is why many people prefer to decorate the walls in a neutral tone and then add to that with artwork that can be moved about the home according to your requirements at the time. It offers flexibility and originality without the commitment of painting directly on a wall.






Positive Symbolism

The infinity symbol is a sign of timelessness, personal empowerment, joy and knowledge

In mathematics it is used to represent a potential infinity rather than actual infinity which is a lovely reminder that we all have infinite potential and therefore there are infinite ways in which we can achieve our goals.






Spirals represent connection between the conscious and subconscious as well as rebirth and transformation.


The spiral is associated with evolution and growth of the spirit as well as our never ending journey of knowledge.

The circle represents wholeness unity and perfection. Great for new starts, it is an uplifting symbol of encouragement.

Pythagoras called the circle "monad," the most perfect of creative forms, without beginning or end, without sides or corners.







I use it either in paint, print or applique. I often also use it as an outline in beads, sequins or gemstones.

Apply it to your wall and look at it every day to feel warm and fuzzy.

Memories and Photographs

The beauty of having a painting made of your memories and photographs is that it can incorporate multiple items and you are not limited to the restrictions of a single image or photo. Neither are you limited by time - a painting with images of how you want your future to look could help to bring it about!

I like to incorporate a quote or personal note in a photo painting: Here are some examples:



This canvas was made for a lady called Shirley who loves the woods and trees and purple is a favourite colour, she also enjoys birdwatching. The flowers in the foreground are Shirley poppies and the quote reads: 'I think that I shall never see a poem lovely as a tree.' by Joyce Kilmer.

This canvas was a gift for a football fan. Selhurst Park Stadium in the sunshine with Kayla the Eagle flying high and the words of the club song 'I'm feeling glad all over...'

The 'K49' on the back of the seat at the front is the seat number of the recipient's season ticket.





Happy memories for three friends who, twenty something years ago had a particularly special weekend at the Reading festival where this photo of them was taken.

I have used that photo and added the line up from that year's festival.

The quote along the bottom reads 'Love is friendship set to music' by Jackson Pollock.

Quotes, Messages and Codes There is a reason quotes are popular. They make you think, they inspire and uplift you and open your mind to possibilities that it wasn't registering at the point at which you looked up and read the quote. As with the memory and photograph canvases, I can incorporate messages, quotes, names and dates either by transfer print, stencil or applique. This is one of my favourites: it reads 'Who Are You And What Do You Want?' Who we are and what we want in life is a fundamental question of our existence. It doesn't matter who we are or what we want, we still reflect on this more than we probably realise.




This is a large canvas, 125×100 cm with 25 people cut out and stitched on by hand. The letters are all hand cut from reflective fabric and machine stitched on to the figures. The paint is all acrylic, with a hint of sparkle.

This painting is a reminder that we are really all the same, no matter what we think we want or who we think we are.



I love a secret message painting, it makes it all the more pleasurable and enjoyable to look at when you are the only person who knows what it really says.



Another thing I love to do is to translate words into numbers. There are a few ways to do this and levels to which you can reduce a sentence to its numerical essence but I find that a balance of mystery and visual prettiness works well.

Frequently we are told to put affirmations on the wall, on the mirror and fridge and so on, but what if someone comes round? You might not want to share your secrets with other people, so a hidden affirmation canvas will keep it in your mind, and yours only.

Can you work out what it says on this canvas?



Semi Precious Stones

You may or may not believe in the properties of gemstones, I have met people that meet this idea with great derision and I have also met people who lean heavily on and rule their life by crystals. Whichever end of the scale you are at, you have to admit they are beautiful.

I have been experimenting and honing the skills of stitching gemstone chips onto canvas to infuse the energy of the space with the properties of the crystals. I first began to consider this concept in the lockdown of 2020; with everyone being at home and frazzled, would it actually make a difference if there was a calming presence imbuing the room with peaceful energy?

Tiger Spiral

Here I have used glass beads which catch the light beautifully alternating with tiger's eye chips.

Tiger's Eye can help reduce anxiety and minimises feelings of isolation or inadequacy by increasing one's feelings of self worth and selfconfidence.


Tiger's Eye helps find balance in times of chaos or upheaval.


And we could all do with some of that!





This is a 50 X 50 cm canvas painted with acrylic inks and pastels around an iridescent heart shape. Radiating out from the heart are lots of opalite beads stitched on with invisible thread. The heart and the colours are there to uplift and promote love, and the opalite is said to allow those who use it to understand how to go with the flow. It casts out negativity with its positive and warm energy. Opalite is also known to put heavy hearts at ease and helps you see life with optimism and curiosity. Having this in your vicinity will bring these properties into your environment and uplift and enrich the energy in your space.

Mini - up to 15 x 20 cm

Small - 15 x 20 to 30 x 40 cm

Medium- 30 x 40 to 40 x 60 cm

Large - 40 x 60 to 80 x 100 cm

Extra Large - 80 x 100 to 150 x 200 cm

The painted canvas is the base price. If you also want a photograph, add the photograph price. If you only want it beaded, for example then just add the beading price.

The price takes into account the amount of beading, number of photos or words, so the table below is not excact, it is there to give you an idea.
